Old Mal Australia Judging Criteria

Revised 2019

OLD MAL/TIMBER:

- Traditional style, grace & flow linking traditional manoeuvres into continual motion.
- Drop knee & reverse drop knee turns, nose riding, tube riding, re- entries delayed floaters.
 - Old Mal is judged on the Grace & Style of the rider completing a repertoire of functional manoeuvres within the pocket of the wave.

LOGGERS:

- Log riding is judged on a Traditional Criteria with continual flow, motion, style & grace in the critical section of the wave.
- We are looking for flowing, controlled turns.... nose riding & stylish graceful manoeuvres with a Major Emphasis on a Clean Transition into your next Manoeuvre with little down time.
- High scoring potential is placed on a Four Step Pattern Walking to & from the nose performed cleanly, Technical Noseriding "only when executed in a clean flowing motion" & linking your next manoeuvre into your repertoire.

EARLY 70's SINGLE FIN, TRANSITIONAL / TRACKERS:

- "Judged on Morning of the Earth Style Surfing".
- Judges are looking for Flow, Power, Continual Motion within the pocket of the wave exhibiting control, style & the ability to perform & complete manoeuvres cleanly.
- Length of ride can be considered in Extreme conditions & Small close out beach breaks.

All surfers are to judge 2 heats prior to their event.

Enjoy the step back in an era of surfing.
